The CDC has just confirmed four cases of local mosquito-borne Zika virus infection in Florida. Because you and your constituents may see national media coverage of this recent development, we wanted to make sure you had the latest information about Zika cases and preparations in our state. Currently, South Carolina does not have any confirmed or suspected local mosquito-borne Zika virus transmissions. All confirmed cases in South Carolina have been travel related.
