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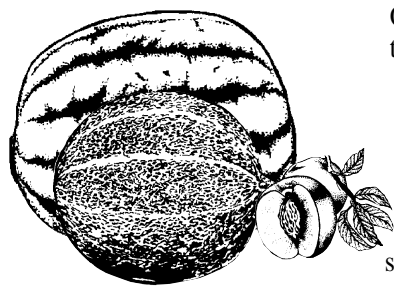
S.C. Cantaloupes, Peaches, and Watermelons—Ripe, ready for July 4th

Expert touts health benefits of soybeans

International demand for soybeans may be on its way to an upsurge as officials prepare to announce the health benefits of eating soybean products, one expert said.

Dr. Mark Messina, who has written many books on the nutritional value of soybeans and worked for the Diet and Cancer Branch of the National Cancer Institute, spoke at this year's S.C. Nutrition Council Annual Meeting on June 23-24, which was sponsored by the S.C. Soybean Board. Messina focused on the important role soybean products could play in preventing cancer, and how farmers should pay close attention to developments and research about soybeans.

Messina said the Food and Drug Administration is preparing to announce that plant estrogens in soybeans help lower cholesterol levels. Messina also points to other health benefits derived from soybeans. He says research suggests that soy products reduce the risk of heart disease and reduce bone loss in post-menopausal women. Because of isoflavones in soybeans, they may also reduce the risk of prostate and breast cancer, Messina said.

All this means South Carolina farmers should watch for soybean research results. Messina said that although soybeans will never replace beef products, they are taking their place in many specialized food markets. And the newfound knowledge of their health benefits should only serve to expand those markets.

"It's excellent," Messina said of the findings. "It helps to enhance awareness of the soybean as a crop and the fact that (the United States) grows half of the world's soybeans. The soy food market can be an important niche market for farmers."

Messina's primary responsibility with the National Cancer Institute was to identify research needs in the area of diet and cancer prevention. He has written, along with his wife, *The Simple Soybean and Your Health*, *The Vegetarian Way* and *The Dietitian's Guide to Vegetarian Diets: Issues and Applications*.

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Commissioner's Column

Leesville says goodbye to 52-year-old stockyard

Old traditions die hard, especially when they've been around for more than 50 years. But sometimes our old traditions must make way for improvement, and that's why Jim Hall and Bobby Coleman have decided to close the Farmers Livestock Market in Leesville and reopen another stockyard in nearby Saluda.

Built in 1947, the livestock market in Leesville, located at the intersection of Hwy. 245 South and Brodie Road, has traded more than a million head of cattle and hogs since its inception. But now Jim and Buddy, the stockyard's owners, have decided another stockyard in Saluda has an unlimited potential for growth, so they're moving their operation there.

The Leesville market has traditionally attracted buyers and producers from Leesville, Batesburg, Columbia, Lexington, Saluda and other cities around the state. The market has also regularly attracted people from neighboring states — mostly Georgia. Jim and Buddy both say the market has enjoyed a reputation of getting top dollar for producers who sell their cattle there, and they want that tradition to continue in Saluda.

The location and surroundings are the only changes folks will notice when the sale moves to Saluda. That's because Jim and Buddy will operate sales at the new stockyard in the same manner they've operated the Leesville sales. The stockyard will be called the Saluda Livestock Market, and sales will continue to be held on Mondays. The stockyard was previously known as the Saluda County Stockyard, and is located at 501 W. Main St. Jim said he expects a smooth transition to Saluda because of wide support from both producers and buyers. The first sale there will be Monday, July 12.

The final sale at the Leesville market will be Monday, June 28. Jim and Buddy are unsure of what will become of the building that's housed the Leesville livestock sales for so many years. Buddy's father, Tom, and Jim bought the stockyard and began operating it in 1966. Jim said he knows many people will feel nostalgic for the old stockyard, even though the move to Saluda will benefit both producers and buyers.

"People are a little sentimental," Jim said. Despite the sentimentality, Jim and Buddy's announcement of the move has mostly met a good response, they said.

"Everyone we've talked to is very positive about this move," Buddy said.

It helps that stockyard-goers won't be straying too far from Leesville, since Saluda is only about 15 miles away. Though the location change is small, it will hopefully attract more people around the state and across the state line from Georgia. The Leesville market now averages about 150 sellers and 38 buyers per sale.

Jim said almost 600 head of cattle and hogs are traded in Leesville each week, and he's hoping that number will increase to at least 800 in Saluda. The Saluda stockyard's barn is 15-20 percent larger than the Leesville barn, and it's 10 years younger. Buddy said the newer facilities will be a big plus, but he's also excited about the location because of a saying he once heard: "All crossroads lead to Saluda." Another plus for moving the market to Saluda County is it's fourth in the state in cattle production.

"It's a good location," Buddy said. "It'll be good for both buyers and sellers. It's an opportunity to open up to a broad spectrum of cattle, because there's a higher concentration of cattle in Saluda."

I believe the move will benefit everyone involved. If more buyers are attracted to the Saluda sale, producers should receive better prices for their product. Similarly, if more producers are present, buyers will have a broader selection of livestock. All that translates into a win-win situation.

"We feel sure the move will have a positive effect on the price," Buddy said. "Hopefully it will encourage prices somewhat."

Jim and Buddy are unique in that they are the only two in the state who own two stockyards. Their other stockyard is in Laurens and is called the Cattlemen's Livestock Center. The sale in Laurens is held each Wednesday at noon.

To make the Saluda stockyard sales as successful as those in Leesville have always been, Buddy and Jim are counting on the folks with whom they've done business in Leesville for so many years.

"We're surrounded by a lot of good people, and that's what made Jim and me what we are," Buddy said.

Buyers Beware...

Buy farm and home products locally!

As telephone scams are becoming endemic across the country, it's important to realize that agricultural products aren't exempt from telemarketers' grasps.

One recent alert to the scams occurred this month. A South Carolina consumer was contacted by a telemarketer who told the client the herbicide he/she sold would control vegetation for up to six seasons. But the customer was dissatisfied with the product when he received it---which sold for a "bargain" \$99.99 a gallon---and found that it was only 3.75 percent of the active ingredient. A Clemson University entomologist researched further and found that a gallon of a similar product had a higher concentration — 25 percent — of the active ingredient.

The price? \$30.

The consumer tried to return the herbicide, but the company told him that he obligated himself to buy more of the product when he purchased the first gallon.

The lesson learned from all of this is "Buyer Beware!" Les Tindal, Commissioner of Agriculture, urges anyone purchasing herbicides or any other products by phone to be extremely cautious. He advises consumers to check with their local extension agent for information on the amount of active ingredients needed and to buy from a local dealer for the best service. "If it sounds too good to be true," Tindal said, "it probably is." He adds, "Ask questions about the product or service, and if you feel you're not getting the information

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melon with a depressed, rounded indenture on the end where it was picked from the stem. In cantaloupe grower lingo this is called a "full slip."

And, just about any peach that you pick will be sweet and tasty, as long as it's a South Carolina-grown peach. Peaches are more plentiful this year than they have been in quite a while, thanks to good weather conditions, for the most part. While South Carolina ranks 2nd in the nation for peach production, our growers produce "The Tastier Peach"---a peach which tastes as good as it looks. Imported peaches just don't have the texture and flavor of South Carolina peaches. Peach varieties available right now include Coronet and the Harvester group among many others.

As for watermelons — everything from ice box size to picnic size is available on the market right now---and all are called

"sweet varieties."

A watermelon which has significantly raised ridges along the melon contour showing maturity and a creamy-colored underside can usually be counted on to be just right.

Pineapple-soy glazed steaks

Ingredients: 2 well-trimmed beef ribeye steaks, cut 1 inch thick. Glaze: 1/4 cup pineapple juice, 1/4 cup soy sauce, 2 tablespoons packed brown sugar, 1 teaspoon cornstarch.

Directions: In 1-cup glass measure, combine glaze ingredients, mix well. Microwave on high 2 1/2 - 3 minutes until thickened, set aside. Place steaks over medium coals, grill uncovered 11-14 mins., turning steaks occasionally and brushing both sized with glaze during the last 5 minutes of grilling. Carve steaks crosswise into thick slices and drizzle with remaining glaze. Serve with grilled pineapple if desired.

“Miz May’s” tips for freezing corn

Fresh sweet corn is one of South Carolina’s summer highlights, but most folks like to enjoy it year-round. So Mrs. Les Tindal, “Miz May,” once again shares her favorite recipe for freezing corn off the cob: Take 20 cups of corn, 5 cups ice water, 1/4 cup salt, 1/4 - 3/4 cups sugar (to individual taste), mix well, put into a container and freeze. Blanching is *not* required. Thaw and pour off excess water before cooking.
