Hurricane Matthew Status of Operations

**11:00 AM
January 30, 2017**

Statewide Summary –SCDOT continues working to repair infrastructure damaged by Hurricane Matthew. In addition to infrastructure repair, SCDOT’s operation to remove storm debris is nearly complete. Vegetative debris operations are complete in all counties. Non-vegetative flood related debris will continue to be removed in a few areas where severe flooding occurred.

Emergency Repair Contracts - 14 Highway/Bridge Contractors have been engaged to assist with 50 different “emergency/spot repairs” in 11 counties. All are South Carolina firms and one firm is a DBE.

Included below is summary information regarding closures and debris accomplishments. Detailed reports are also attached.

14/2 Road / Bridge Closures due to Matthew - as of the time of this report. Included in this total are 2 closures on primary routes.

1,979,308 Cubic yards of storm related debris removed.




