Description/Significant Features: Road 1306.09 (unnamed logging road) is a circa 1970 road that connects Roads 1306.07 and 1306.08, extending 0.63 mile northwest/southeast through the eastern portion of the project tract (see Figures 3.21 and 3.22). Road 1306.09 averages 20 ft wide, 30 ft amsl elevation, and its surface is an aggregate of dirt and gravel. For most of its course, the roadbed is at ground level, except where it crosses a narrow drainage and raised two to three ft above ground surface.

Historical Information

Historical Information: These investigations identified 14 roads associated with Watson Hill's logging era, circa 1925-2006. These include seven historic roads (Roads 1306.08-1306.14) and seven non-historic roads (Roads A-G). These roads were developed by logging enterprises in the early to mid-twentieth century to facilitate silvicultural activities at Watson Hill.

The USGS (1973) shows Road 1306.09 integrated into the logging road network. The USGS (1980) topographic map shows Road 1306.09 as an unimproved road.
