I have just returned from a very brief meeting of the Richland County Recreation Commission board.

Board members voted unanimously to KEEP SECRET from Gov. Haley the Dec./ 9, 2015 investigation that examines sex harassment allegations against former director James Brown III. In other words, they REFUSE to turn it over to the governor.

But members WILL release about 500 pages of other information pertaining to the governor's other requests, made in her Oct. 13 letter to the board members.

A RCRC spokesman said the commission will deliver the information that it is turning over to the governor to her offices Friday morning, the day of her deadline.

It was a very short meeting, and commissioners refused all comment. Six of the 7 board members were present.
