A called meeting of the Anderson County Council was held on January 8, 1991 at 5:00 p.m. in the Anderson County Council Chambers. Chairman Mike Holden presided.

Chairman Mike Holden called the meeting to order and Ms. Cahaly gave the invocation. Everyone stood and pledged allegiance to the flag.

Chairman Holden explained that an executive session was needed to discuss personnel and contractual matters. Mr. Holden therefore moved to go into executive session at 5:10 p.m. for the reasons stated and Ms. Cahaly seconded. Vote was four in favor (Hooper absent).

Mr. Holden moved to come out of executive session back into regular session at 8:10 p.m. Mr. Banister seconded and vote was 4-0.

Mr. Holden explained that during executive session Council discussed four major issues which are as follows. 1) David Bevill and David Watson to report back as to finalization of contract engineer and to get in house engineering in 30 days. This move to save money for Anderson County. 2) Direct the County administrator to begin advertising for a full time attorney to represent all phases of County government. Senator Mullinax will no longer be involved in representing Anderson County in legal matters. 3) Rusty Burns tendered his resignation in executive session as Assistant Administrator to concentrate on duties of the Planning and Development Board. Council sincerely appreciates his honest efforts trying to handle a job that Council placed on him. 4) David Watson now has sole responsibility for Administration of County government. He will have the backing of this Council for a probationary period of six months and will then be re-evaluated. Council expresses gratitude to him for his job performance under difficult circumstances. Mr. Holden moved to approve the above four directives and Mr. Waldrep seconded. Vote was 4-0.

Council heard from Mr. Brantley Jordan. There being no further business, Council adjourned at 8:15 p.m.
