South Carolina's Offshore Opportunity

The Obama administration's new five-year plan for [offshore energy](http://cts.vresp.com/c/?JackGerardAPI/9a0011f631/2505242c36/a6113393b6) [<http://cts.vresp.com/c/?JackGerardAPI/9a0011f631/2505242c36/a6113393b6>](http://cts.vresp.com/c/?JackGerardAPI/9a0011f631/2505242c36/a6113393b6) is making headlines for allowing energy exploration in the Atlantic for the first time in decades. Although it's a positive step, the plan doesn't go nearly far enough in allowing access to the [87 percent](http://cts.vresp.com/c/?JackGerardAPI/9a0011f631/2505242c36/07945ef785/section=energy-and-opportunity-in-the-eastern-gulf) [<http://cts.vresp.com/c/?JackGerardAPI/9a0011f631/2505242c36/07945ef785/section=energy-and-opportunity-in-the-eastern-gulf>](http://cts.vresp.com/c/?JackGerardAPI/9a0011f631/2505242c36/07945ef785/section=energy-and-opportunity-in-the-eastern-gulf) of federal offshore acreage that is off limits to development.

The Interior Department's offshore oil and natural gas leasing plan for 2017-2022 only includes one potential Atlantic lease sale – six years from now. - 88 percent agree increased oil and natural gas production could strengthen America's energy security.
- 82 percent agree that producing more U.S. oil and natural gas could help lower energy costs for consumers.
- 82 percent say increased oil and natural gas production could benefit federal and state budgets through lease payments, royalty fees and other sources of revenue.
- 59 percent say that the federal government does not do enough to encourage U.S. oil and natural gas development.

We'll never reach our full potential as an energy superpower by keeping so many of our resources locked away.
