M I N U T E S

Mr. Poore called the meeting to order and Mr. Kinley gave the invocation.

On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to approve the minutes from the August 31, 1982 meeting as mailed.

Mr. Steve Maher from Kaiser Aluminum spoke to County Council on all aluminum bridge material. Council received as information.

Mr. David Crenshaw asked Council for approval to transfer \$24,000 from Acct. #210.17 (Fuel & Oil) to Acct. #210.85 (Machines & Equipment) in order to cover purchase of radios approved earlier. On the motion of Mr. Bratcher, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to allow the transfer.

Mr. Thad Arnold discussed the bids that were received for renovations of the Court-house. He stated that Triangle Construction Company was the low bidder and the bid seemed to be in order and recommended that Council go with them. On the motion of Mr. Hooper, seconded by Mr. Wright, Council voted unanimously to award the bid to Triangle and to go with the Base Bid and all three alternates. Council directed Mr. Watson to get all the figures for furniture and fixtures for the judges' offices and report back at the next meeting.

Mr. Watson discussed the end of the full maintenance coverage on the elevator. He explained a proposed maintenance and service agreement from Dover for five years in which the service would include parts and maintenance for \$253.76 per month. On the motion of Mr. Wright, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to accept the contract and to transfer \$1,500 from Acct. #158.27 (Repairs to Buildings) to 158.65 (Consulting and Contractual Services).

Mr. Kinley presented and read a Proclamation proclaiming September as Literacy Month. On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to sign the proclamation for Anderson County.

Mr. Lusk presented third and final reading of Kent, Inc. Project for \$350,000 (Ord. #90 Industrial Development Revenue Note and second reading of Torrington Project (Ord. #95) for Council's approval. On the motion of Mr. Kinley, seconded by Mr. Rhodes, Council voted unanimously to approve the two Ordinances (#90 & #95).

Traynam
Mr. Michael Traynam with the Corp of Engineers, asked Council to combine all the various boat ramps on one lease. He proposed that Council amend the lease for Brown Road Ramp to include: Jack's Landing, White City Access, Hurricane Creek Ramp, Ponderosa Ramp, and Hoit Tilley Ramp. He stated we could probably get a rider on our present insurance to cover all areas. These to be maintained by the County. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Kinley, Council voted unanimously to approve the lease as amended and to confirm by letter. Mr. Poore will contact Mr. Duke of Wildlife Resources about funding \$4,800 for routine maintenance of the areas.

Mr. Pat Flack asked Council for some start-up money for the Human Resources Commission. He asked Council to advance them about \$9,000 to start the program for building, maintenance and secretary. Mr. Poore directed Mr. Flack to check with Mr. Jake Barker at the Agriculture Building to see if he has any extra office space.

Mr. Hooper stated that he had his list of roads for the next paving bid.

Mr. Watson discussed the need for authorization for patching money. He recommended that \$30,000 be approved due to the volume of roads being patched to keep the account from running short. On the motion of Mr. Rhodes, seconded by Mr. Hooper, Council voted unanimously to submit the next list of roads for paving (\$75,000 per District) and to send out bids, and to include \$30,000 for patching.

Mr. Rhodes stated that Mr. Norris had requested that Sitton Road be tar and graveled. However, Mr. Walters, County Engineer, had reported that Sitton Road was not a County Road. Mr. Poore stated that there had been quite a controversy about that road.

Mr. Bratcher wants the County to do all his tar and gravel. Mr. Kinley requested that Old Mill Road be tar and graveled in his district.

Council adjourned at 10:15 a.m.
