

A PROPOSED PROCEDURE FOR PLANNING IN
HEALTH AND MEDICAL EDUCATION

- I. The policies and procedures for planning in health and medical education will be the responsibility of the Standing Committee on Health and Medical Education of the Commission on Higher Education, subject to policy guidance by the Commission.
- II. The specific studies, analyses, and recommendations that will form the basis for the health and medical components of the Master Plan for Higher Education will be generated by task forces that will report directly to the Committee on Health and Medical Education.
- III. The Task Forces on health and medical education will be as follows:
 - A. Task Force on Medical Doctor Education
 - B. Task Force on Nursing Education (Statewide Master Planning Committee on Nursing Education)
 - C. Task Force on Allied Health Education
 - D. Task Force on Biomedical Research
 - E. Task Force on Interrelationships Among Various Health Professions
- IV. The Health Education Authority (HEA), which is advisory to the Standing Committee on Health and Medical Education in matters of program review and planning, will review the reports of the Task Forces on planning for health and medical education in terms of broad objectives, missions of specific institutions, relationship to health plans developed by the State Health Coordinating Council and Health Systems Agencies, and five-year plans prepared by the public educational institutions. Commentary and suggestions by HEA will be submitted to the Standing Committee on Health and Medical Education.

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
