The report should include the following two key findings in the recommendations section:

1. Suggest a recommendation highlighting some of the findings from Gary Glenn's (CHE) handout titled "The Maintenance Myth." Namely that "the state's share of higher education's annual maintenance needs" is \$19.9 million. I also recommended highlighting the "myth" that "higher education has accumulated \$1.2B in Deferred Maintenance."
2. Also suggest a recommendation highlighting that the treasurer testified that the retirement systems unfounded liability is getting worse by \$1.5 billion a year and the task force recognizes that as increased debt that should be taken into account before considering additional debt on top of it.
