

August 27, 1943

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's office on August 27, 1943 at 11 o'clock, all members of the Commission being present.

Mr. A. F. Funderburk, Editor of the South Carolina Magazine, appeared before the Commission and requested a contribution of \$1,000.00 to assist in the publication of a special pictorial edition of the magazine. The Commission agreed to contribute the amount requested with the understanding that at least five thousand copies would be turned over to the Governor for distribution through his office and State Departments.

Mr. R. H. McElveen appeared before the Commission and requested a contribution of \$1,000.00 as the State's portion of a building program in cooperation with the Federal Government in connection with the program for the control of venereal diseases in South Carolina, the Federal Government to supply under this agreement approximately \$50,000.00. The Commission approved a warrant for \$1,000.00 for this purpose from the Contingent Fund for National Defense.

The Commission discussed further the retirement of institutional bonds as authorized in the 1943-44 General Appropriation Act, but no definite action was taken pending receipt of information on these bonds being assembled by the Secretary.

The Commission then adjourned.
