Following emancipation, some freed people left Rose Hill while others remained and became tenant farmers. In both slavery and freedom, African-Americans worked hard to forge a life for themselves and their families at Rose Hill Plantation.

Experience a first-person historical interpretation of the life, trials, tribulations and triumphs of a slave named Adam as portrayed by noted historian and historic interpreter Dontavious Williams. *The Chronicles of Adam* will take place at 2 p.m. on the lawn.

- Self-guided tour of the first floor of Gist Mansion
- Ranger-led walk to visit the remains of 19th-century tenant farmer's home
