Lee, D.S., for Dr. J. Wallace, in January 1870, of twenty-five acres of land lying between the Camden Road on the North and the Garner's Ferry Road on the South; West by lands of Mr. Stark and General Wade Hampton, and East by lands formerly of the estate of Latta and Phillip Schwarts; said lot No. 9 herexby conveyed being a portion of said tract of 25 acres, and contains one acre; Bounded as follows, to-wit: on the North by Lot No. 5 and lands of Mr. Stark, which separates it from the Camden Road; East by Lot No. 10, South by a lane which separates it from lot No. 12, and West by lot No. 8.

Y. Lee, D.C., for Dr. J. Wallace in January 1870, said lot hereby conveyed being bounded on the North by

lot No. 5 of said plat and land of Thomas Stark; East by lot No. 10 of said plat; South by a road or lane which separates it from part of lot No. 12 owned by Carter Johnson, and West by the Western half of said lot No. 9.

NOTE: Due to the long passage of time the absence of a dower renunciation is, in the opinion of the abstractor, immaterial.
