Subject: Family members, friends, and brother RUEs:

Family members, friends, colleagues, and brother RUEs:

Between now and Wednesday afternoon I will release three or four new pieces – then a few more the week after that.

You may be taken off guard by the concepts offered. At the core is a principled and mercenary remedy for the moral and ethical dilemma nearly half the citizens of the United States now face. None of the concepts involve any sort of suggestion or advocacy of physical conflict, confrontation, or harm. Some include collaboration among unlikely entities.

I'm refining the arrangement and packaging, as well as the vehicles and staging by which they will be broadcast further. I will certainly not rely on the well-known media outlets to publish the pieces – or excerpts thereof.

As you have probably noticed the pieces I write are distributed to several disclosed news/opinion outlets and one or two disclosed individuals. You probably have guessed disclosed recipients represent a fraction of the distribution.

I will say this: If you have read much of the sixty five pieces written and distributed over the past year, you may recall references to “turning the tables” as Jesus did twice (the second time a day or two before his trial and sentencing). You may also recall a reference or two to the battle between the Israelites and the Philistines – including the story of David and Goliath. While these certainly foreshadow some concepts, one of the most important ancient references is the wisdom of Solomon exhibited when he was confronted by two women who both claimed to be the mother of a baby.

Here's a hint: The strategies that will be advanced do not involve “dividing the baby in half”; that approach worked with the baby's fate because one party was willing to withdraw completely for the greater good. A similar dilemma faced the citizens of our nation between 1787 and 1860 - and the climactic melee resulted in a partial solution that left critical, essential issues unresolved and postponed. Some of those issues remain largely unresolved today.

The enemies of the “greater good” and the “general will of the people” (not what you

may think that phrase means) are animated in the two primary candidates for what has evolved to become one of the most critical roles in the world.

Both candidates are personally so unsatisfactory to a large portion of the citizenry as to cause major faults in the foundations for reasonably peaceful and productive coexistence.

Both candidates must be prevented from ascending to the Presidency – or the contest winner functionally incapacitated as soon as possible after the November 5 election. “Functionally incapacitated” does not imply any sort of physical harm; only rendered - through various means that do not involve physical harm or debilitation in any way - unable to effectively fulfil the role.

The Achilles heel of the two candidates is different, so strategies must be readied to quickly and surely incapacitate the contest winner so that the prescribed mechanisms of the US Constitution can be engaged.

My role and the roles of many like me - of all social, financial, and political perspectives - will not be to endorse, support, or vote for one or the other. The roles will be akin to those of the early thought leaders of the nation in its infancy and youth. Our nation needs to be reborn free of the contamination and dysfunction championed by both major party candidates.

Read about Dr. John Nash’s Game Playing Theory for more background regarding dealing with false dichotomies and dilemmas. The next half-dozen pieces to be issued will fit together to compose an integrated strategy.
