Holly and Tony, Will and I have discussed whether to file an Answer rather than a Motion to Dismiss, and have concluded that an Answer is probably the better way to go. We would plan to move for summary judgment fairly shortly thereafter, and of course would be able to include affidavits, etc., and not be bound to accept the allegations of the Complaint. I have not seen anything from Will to you two today about this, but we had an e-mail problem for a little while earlier today.

A draft Answer is attached for your review. We would prefer to file it this coming Monday, which would have been the due date in state court. We really have until at least Thursday (7 days after the notice of removal), but Plaintiff's counsel may not know that. In fact, I am not sure Plaintiff's counsel is even admitted to the federal bar at present.

Please review this and advise Will and me on Monday of any changes you see that need to be made. We will look it over again ourselves, and if this approach is all right, we will file and serve it on Monday. By the way, this case has been assigned to Joe Anderson, which is usually a good thing.
