Chris Baucom from ACT contacted me last week and followed that up with the email below. Although not for public consumption yet, Chris wanted us to know that South Carolina will be 1 of the 5 initial states participating in the CWRC Academy. He asked two questions that I am passing on to you:

1. How does SC/Governor want to announce this as a state? ACT stands ready to assist SC – just let them know how we want to roll this out & what we need from them.
2. The President of ACT, Martin Scaglione, has reserved the week of January 30th to conduct fly-ins to the participating states. Totally the State's decision, but is SC interested in this? Chris indicated that Martin could meet with the Governor, Manufacturers Alliance, etc.

Good chatting earlier this week about South Carolina and CWRC. As we discussed, I am sending you a quick overview of the advisory board. I am afraid I spoke a little too soon about sharing the roster -- we have two people who have not confirmed, but the list should be set within a week or so.

Our plan is to send formal notification to the first group of states on Jan. 3, and let states make their own announcements throughout early Jan (with whatever support you would like us to provide). We will do a big announcement summarizing all states plus the advisory board launch on Jan. 23-24, followed by visits from Martin Scaglione week of Jan 30, if South Carolina is interested in that. Please let me know what we can do to help South Carolina make this a successful launch.
