

Housing Board Picks Geddings

William R. Geddings, who served as manager of University Terrace since it was opened, has been named supervising manager in charge of administration of Columbia's low cost housing projects, W. S. Hendley, chairman of the Columbia housing authority, has announced.

Mr. Geddings has taken over the management of Gonzales Gardens, which is expected to open in August, and Allen-Benedict court, in addition to University Terrace.

Under his administration University Terrace has gained national recognition as one of the outstanding projects in the country.

Before he was named manager of University Terrace, Mr. Geddings was on the reportorial staff of The State.

When Gonzales Gardens is opened, Mr. Geddings will move his office to that project. The office is located at University Terrace at present.

He explained today that approximately 300 applications had been received for apartments in Gonzales Gardens. Applications are not being received for apartments in Allen-Benedict court.
