Martin Marietta Materials has acquired 267 acres of land for a proposed rock quarry in the small community of Bowling Green, with plans to purchase additional acreage. The properties were acquired over a period of three to four years from out-of-town land owners by a third party. He deceptively stated his intent in purchasing the land was to have a hunting preserve and catfish ponds. He never mentioned a proposed rock quarry in his negotiations.

We would like to discuss the issues surrounding this proposed quarry with someone in your office with the hope that we can stop the quarry from coming into our community.

The proposed quarry will be a detriment to any future growth of the area and most certainly to the values of our properties and the well being of residents. The land in question has belonged to the Adams and Dulin families for generations and remaining descendants of these families are definitely impacted should Martin Marietta Materials complete their plans.

We realize that we are going into battle with a multibillion dollar business, but we feel our community, homes, land and overall well being are worth the fight.
