**1890 Extension Youth Livestock Awareness
Program Seeking Students, Schools and
Producers to Participate**

Since many youth are unfamiliar with the various aspects of agriculture, especially livestock production, the 1890 Cooperative Extension Program at South Carolina State University wants to offer young people exposure to on farm experiences.

The 1890 Extension Youth Livestock Awareness Program is designed to provide limited resource students in Orangeburg, Calhoun, Dorchester and Bamberg counties opportunities to receive training in livestock principles. Through participation with the Youth Livestock Awareness Program, the students will receive an inside view of agricultural concepts and learn the principles of livestock ownership via collaboration with the 1890 Extension Youth Livestock Awareness Program.

Christine Sineath, associate county agent, 1890 Extension Youth Livestock Awareness Program, Orangeburg Cluster, said the program is in search of local livestock producers who are willing to allow these youths to visit their farms in the afternoons and work with livestock. As well, teachers and schools are encouraged to become involved with the program.

Because the program is just getting started, coordinators welcome the donation of halters, expertise and grooming equipment.

Participating students will make farm visits during the week and on weekends to work with livestock and their owners. This allows the students to become familiar with animal handling techniques, nutrition, breeding, and other aspects of livestock care. Near the end of the school year, the students and their respective livestock animals will participate in a livestock show. This is where they will be judged on their livestock handling ability.

Commissioner's Column

Farm-City Week— SC Gives Thanks

As you prepare for your Thanksgiving dinner---the succulent turkey, the sweet potatoes and pecan pie---I invite you to join me in giving thanks to the 4.6 million people who live and work on farms to provide us with such a wonderful bounty.

Farm-City Week, November 17-23, salutes the men and women who work every day to provide millions of Americans with numerous products, from the Thanksgiving turkey to the detergent for washing dishes and to the paper napkins or to the walls around us. This week is a time to reflect on our blessings, and a time to develop cooperation, encourage understanding, and solidify relations between rural and urban residents.

Founded by Kiwanis International Agriculture and Conservation Committee, Farm-City Week was established to unify all workers---farmers and non-farmers. Thanksgiving, the holiday on which we give thanks for our blessings, is the appropriate time to reflect on the interdependence of all people---people from all walks of life engaged in the business of providing food, fiber, and shelter.

Farmers grow raw products. Processors manufacture those raw products into finished goods. Everyone from the farm worker to the cashier at the supermarket is involved with getting food to your table. Everyone from the scout who monitors boll weevils to the clerk in the clothing store is involved in providing you clothing. And, everyone from the forester to the clerk at the home improvement center is involved in making your home comfortable. Every job---rural and urban---is linked to agriculture in one way or another.

Neither a farm nor a city can exist in isolation. Hand in hand the two create jobs, products, markets, and relationships that maintain our strong economy. During Farm-City Week, South Carolina counties will help strengthen this bond through various activities throughout the state.

For instance, in Lexington County, a job exchange will take place between a farmer and another businessman. This year, Ricky Frick, who works with his father at Roy J. Frick and Sons Farms, will be taking a step into the shoes of Tommy Harmon, an employee of PDT Telephone Company.

The pair will spend a day learning about each other's vocation and will later share their experiences at the Farm-City Banquet. The banquet will be a time of celebration as two to three hundred people unite in honor of Farm-City Week. Frick and Harmon will share slides and stories of their day as businessmen which will be a learning experience for both. By walking in each other's shoes for a day, they will be able to see first-hand just how much they really depend on each other. Farm and city business people are like bread and butter . . . *neither is quite as good without the other!*

The banquet will also involve the young people, as Lexington County celebrates Farm-City Week with the local S.C. FFA and 4-H chapters. The adolescents will help make the banquet a success. Earlier, in October, they assisted with a Farm-City showcase that promoted a variety of businesses, once again encouraging the interdependence of rural and urban communities.

In addition to Lexington events, Saluda County will be holding their award-winning event, "The Taste & See", where outdoor exhibits of antique and new farm equipment combine with the delectable aromas of food to provide an all-around look at South Carolina agriculture. They will also hold a Farm-City Banquet to celebrate Farm-City Week.

Many other activities like these will be held around the state during Farm-City Week to celebrate South Carolina's proud agricultural heritage. Since 1993, we have maintained a steady rate of about 25,000 farms that average 194 acres in size. Our farmers provide us with many of the items grown and produced on the farm that you will enjoy on Thanksgiving.

As you sit down to your meal, please join my family and me in giving thanks to the people who work day and night to provide you with nourishment to carry on your activities. Farmer or non-farmer---be a "Partner in Progress".
