The city of Rock Hill has added a \$7 million motocross facility to its outdoor recreation venues in the growing Riverwalk development along the Catawba River. The new Novant Health BMX Supercross Track features amateur and Supercross start hills and a pump track, and will be the only Olympic-caliber BMX training facility on the East Coast. The facility also includes a concession stand, offices, a maintenance building and two multi-purpose athletic fields.

Three major events are already scheduled at the track, including the 2014 Gold Cup East Finals in mid October; the UCI BMX Supercross World Cup on Sept. 25-26, 2015; and the UCI BMX World Championships on July 26-30, 2017.

Other recently developed recreation facilities in Rock Hill's Riverwalk area are the Giordana Velodrome bicycling track, the Piedmont Medical Center Trail, new mountain bike trails, a kayak/canoe launch, and the Rock Hill Outdoor Center Greens.
