**WHEREAS,** serving every community across our state and nation, the United States Postal Service is a great asset to the people of South Carolina; and

**WHEREAS,** the United States Postal Service did an excellent job in re-establishing delivery to all South Carolinians in the aftermath of the historic flood event in October 2015; and

**WHEREAS,** with nearly 400 postal facilities, the Greater South Carolina District of the United States Postal Service has 6,856 employees who serve 3.9 million of our state's 4.8 million residents six days a week; and

**WHEREAS,** 22 percent of the postal employees in the Greater South Carolina District are veterans of military service, and 332 of those 1,540 employees are 30 percent or more disabled; and

**WHEREAS,** South Carolina is proud to honor the courageous members of our country's Armed Forces who defend our freedom during times of peace and conflict.

**NOW, THEREFORE,** I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim November 11, 2015, as
