On behalf of the U.S. Dept. of Housing and Urban Development, we would like to invite you to a stakeholder call with Deputy Secretary Jones on Friday, March 15 at 1:30 p.m. EST to talk about the potential impacts of sequestration on HUD programs and operations. As you are likely aware, due to the inability of Congress to pass legislation on balanced deficit reduction to avoid sequestration, the President was required by law to issue a sequestration order on March 1 canceling approximately \$85 billion in budgetary resources across the Federal government for the remainder of the Federal fiscal year. At this time, HUD is taking every step possible to mitigate the effects of these cuts.
