
Dear Mr. Fuller:

I am writing with regard to the CSX derailment in Berkeley County on April 28. This derailment caused significant damage to the structure referenced above. As a result, the structure will need to be replaced. CSX has already had preliminary conversations with your team and we stand ready to assist in quickly moving this project forward and towards completion.

Further, since the train derailment caused the damage, we are prepared to reimburse the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SC DOT) for the full replacement cost of a comparable bridge. CSX regrets the inconvenience caused by this derailment and is committed to ensuring the bridge is repaired in a safe and timely manner and will work as quickly as possible to review all necessary design plans and agreements. Our goal is to move the process along and not to impede progress.

CSX is grateful for the assistance provided to us by local and state officials in the aftermath of this derailment and look forward to continuing a productive relationship with SC DOT. Please let me know if I can be of any further assistance.
