Correction in the letter regarding the judge's ruling date:

Judge Issues Ruling in NMVTIS Lawsuit by Consumer Groups

On Monday, September 22, federal Judge Marilyn Hall Patel ruled in favor of consumer groups to require the Department of Justice to implement NMVTIS immediately. The judge required the Department of Justice to issue the final rule implementing NMVTIS by January 30, 2009 and the rule must be effective by the end of March 2009. This means insurance companies, salvage yards and junk yards would have to start submitting their data to NMVTIS by March 2009. She also required consumer to be given access to NMVTIS no later than January 30, 2009. AAMVA is currently awaiting DOJ's reactions to determine the impact of the lawsuit on the states and newly issued NPRM.
