This is a 1-story frame residence with vinyl siding. The house is rectangular in plan with the long side facing the street, surmounted by a lateral gable roof with a small front gable covering one bay on the left side. The asymmetrical 5-bay facade features an off-center single door flanked on each side by two double windows. The one-story open porch projects from the right side of the house, and is protected by a shed roof and is supported by slender wooden posts.
