**Admissions /Enrollment Update**

**Summer School 2014 Registration/Enrollment**

As of June 11, 2014, there are 742 unduplicated students with schedules for summer school 2014. The final enrollment for summer 2013 was 876. A five year summer enrollment comparison by student characteristics is attached. The 2014 preliminary summer enrollment is also included in the attachment.

**Fall 2014 Admissions** – As of June 11, 2014 (see tables 1 and 2), a total of 6,178 applications (6,027 undergraduates and 151 graduates) have been received. Of the 6,178 applications received, 2,633 students (2,626 undergraduates and 7 graduates) have been admitted and 513 have an enrollment deposit. The final admission data for fall 2013 is provided in tables 3 and 4. There were 4,787 applications received and 2,708 students admitted. The final enrollment for fall 2013 was 3,463 students. A five year fall enrollment comparison by student characteristics is attached.

**Satisfactory Academic Progress (SAP) - Students Enrolled for Academic Year 2013-14**

A total of 740 continuing students were notified of their SAP status. This could have an effect on fall 2014 enrollment if students have no means of funding except Title IV.

**Financial Aid Academic Year 2014-2015**

As of June 11, 2014, a total of 6,406 FAFSA applications have been received from new and continuing students. Of the 6,406 FAFSA received, 3,541 have been awarded financial aid. See table 7 below.

- During 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 the federal loan program was under the FFELP (Federal Family Education Loan Program). Limited data is available for 2008-2009 and 2009-2010 as the applicants applied with the lender but very few plus loans were approved.
- Effective Summer 2010, SC State began participating in the Federal Direct Loan Program.
- From 2010 – 2011 there was a tremendous increase in the number of plus loan approvals due to the transition from the FFELP to the Direct Loan Program.
- During 2011-2012, the plus loan approvals decreased 5% when compared to 2010-2011.
- Academic Year 2012-2013 resulted in a reduction of 15% in plus loan applicants from 2011 – 2012.
- Since the inception of the Direct Loan Program in 2010 to the academic year 2013, there has been an overall reduction of nearly 21% in plus loan approvals.
- Academic Year 2013-14 resulted in an increase of 6.28% in plus loan applicants from 2012-2013.

**Retention Data**

**Fall 2013 to Spring 2014** – Retention rate was 87.5% (2,859 returning students out of 3,267).

**Fall 2012 to Spring 2013** - Retention rate was 86.8 % (3,150 returning students out of 3,628).
