John,
It was great to meet with you and get your input on the feasibility study last week. As you requested, I am attaching a copy of the presentation and the studies cited. There is a zip file of studies that are not easily accessible, and a file containing links to those available online. Please note that we are working on incorporating the very useful comments you made last week but haven't finished yet, so this is almost the same version you saw then.

I wanted to mention that I asked about the changes you told us about in your policy for reimbursing elective, non-medically necessary deliveries before 39 weeks. It is my understanding that, since we are defining preterm as less than 37 weeks, we are not capturing those elective births, since they generally do not happen before 37 weeks. If that is not right, please let me know and we will see if we can figure out how to account for the change.

Let me know if you or any of your staff have questions, and if you have updated data.
