The program is administered by private driver education schools who are under regulation by the Governor's Highway Safety Office. We have a graduated drivers license program also. We have a graduated license with a requirement for formal driver education between the beginner's permit and the conditional license (allows them to drive by themselves only during the day). I was meeting with one of our senators yesterday, and he is very interested in an additional requirement for a course similar to Alive at 25. I know that Colorado requires this course, but do you know of any other states where this course or one like it is required? If so, do you know any contacts that I could talk with about the implementation of such a program?
