WHEREAS, the symptoms of multiple sclerosis are variable, ranging from abnormal fatigue or numbness in the limbs to blindness or complete paralysis; and

WHEREAS, most people with multiple sclerosis are diagnosed between the ages of 20 and 50; and

WHEREAS, even though there is presently no cure for this disease, medications and therapeutic treatments are available to help manage the symptoms and enable those affected to achieve maximum independence; and

WHEREAS, research continues to bring us closer to a cure while contributing to the development of improved treatment options that enhance the quality of life for people affected by multiple sclerosis.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim March 11 - 17, 2013, as
