Mr. Andrew H. DuPre and Mr. Roy Attaway, of the State Board of Fisheries, appeared before the Commission and requested an allotment of \$10,000.00 from the 1948-49 Civil Contingent Fund to purchase and operate a shrimp patrol boat. After some discussion of the matter, the Commission agreed to supply the sum of \$7,000.00. for this purpose.

The Commission declined to approve a transfer in the amount of \$1,000.00 requested by the Commissioner of Labor for the purpose of increasing the salary of the Commissioner for the year 1948.

The Commission declined to grant the request of The Citadel for an increase in its 1947-48 appropriation in the sum of \$44,821.00, the request being based on Section 74 of the Appropriations Act for the year 1947-48.

The Commission declined to approve a request of the University of South Carolina for a Cortingent Fund allotment of \$1,031.93 to cover the cost of litigation by the University in the case of Wrighten vs. Board of Trustees University of South Carolina.

The Commission then adjourned.
