**WHEREAS,** public lands throughout South Carolina and the nation provide natural and cultural resources for environmental learning, wildlife appreciation, and recreation; and

**WHEREAS,** National Public Lands Day is an innovative, public/private partnership event that encourages volunteers of all ages to work together restoring and enhancing our federal, state, and local public lands; and

**WHEREAS,** the 2014 observance of National Public Lands Day provides a unique opportunity to raise awareness of the importance of land conservation and stewardship to our quality of life.

**NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim September 27, 2014, as**
