Description/Significant Features:

One-story, cinderblock house with a hipped roofline. Front elevation has a four bays, with a slightly off-center doorway; to the north is a single-pane picture window and a single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash window, while to the south is a single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash window. A two-bay, gabled porch, supported by square posts, covers the door and the picture window. The house is two bays deep, with single six-over-six, double-hung, wooden sash windows on the northern elevation and an additional entry door on the southern elevation.
