The Budget and Control Board met in the Conference Room of the Governor's Office at 12:45 P. M., May 2, 1973, with all members present except State Treasurer Grady L. Patterson, Jr.. P. C. Smith, Secretary, was also present.

Governor West advised the Board that the General Appropriation Bill for 1973-74, now before the General Assembly, includes provision for the construction of two additional State Office buildings. He further advised that he had received formal communications from the General Assembly suggesting names for these two buildings.

After considering the Legislative communications, the Board unanimously agreed on naming these buildings as follows:

- (1) The proposed building to be located at the former intersection (now closed) of Senate and South Main Streets immediately behind the State House, shall be named the L. Marion Gressette Building.
- (2) The proposed building to be located on the corner of Pendleton Street and the recently closed 1000 Block of South Main Street, shall be named the Solomon Blatt Building.

No further business was considered and the meeting adjourned at 1:00
