SECTION 1: Commissioner Harvey, Chairman of the Executive Director Search Committee, introduced Governor Carroll Campbell who administered the oath of office to new Executive Director Daniel P. Fanning. Mr. Fanning thanked the Governor and the Commission for the confidence placed in him with the appointment as Executive Director and pledged to work diligently for the good of the Department and the State.

SECTION 2: The Minutes for the meeting of December 17, 1992, copies of which had been previously mailed to each member of the Commission were approved.

SECTION 3: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the monthly reports as published by the Department of activities for the month of December, 1992.

SECTION 4: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving purchase orders issued for amounts in excess of \$10,000.00, during the month of December, 1992, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 5: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to increase the previous approved estimated cost of consulting firms for "on-call" photogrammetric services over a two year period, for an estimated increase of \$370,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 6: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with the Highway Users Federation the study of S. C. highway program at an estimated cost of \$2,500.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 7: On motion of Commissioner Harvey, seconded by Commissioner Harrell, the Commission unanimously passed a motion to delay action on the recommendation for an agreement with the North Carolina Department of Transportation for the replacement of the Buster Boyd Bridge over Lake Wylie.

SECTION 8: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into an agreement with Horry County to hire a consulting engineering firm to conduct a drainage study of the Raccoon Run watershed, which extends from south of S. C. 544 near Surfside Beach to the Intracoastal Waterway at an estimated cost of \$25,000.00 with the Department providing on-third of the cost (8,334.00), as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 9: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with Horry County Higher Education Commission (HEC) in order to obtain additional engineering services on the proposed Carolina Bays Parkway in Horry and Georgetown Counties at an estimated cost of \$205,000.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 10: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into a contract with Moreland Altobelli Associates, Inc., for preliminary engineering services to prepare plans and specifications for the SC 35 overpass over CSXRR/Godley Road/Monkey Spring Branch in Lexington County at an estimated cost of \$896,448.78, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 11: The Commission unanimously passed a motion authorizing the Department to enter into Supplemental Agreement Nos. 2 and 3 with B. P. Barber and Associates, Inc., for the purpose of upgrading wastewater treatment at the I-26 rest area in Newberry and the I-95 rest area in Colleton County, at an estimated cost of \$50,600.00, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 12: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department concerning the execution of a gratis quitclaim deed September 10, 1992 conveying approximately 3.295 acres of land in Spartanburg County to James C. Eubanks, III, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 13: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department concerning the execution of a gratis quitclaim deed dated September 10, 1992 conveying approximately a 2 acre parcel of land in Spartanburg County to James C. Eubanks, III, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 14: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department concerning the execution of a gratis quitclaim deed dated October 26, 1992 conveying approximately 0.11 acre of land in Charleston County to Pastime Amusement Company, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 15: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department concerning the execution of a gratis quitclaim deed dated January 7, 1993 conveying approximately 0.62 acre of land in Berkeley County to the City of Goose Creek, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 16: The Commission unanimously passed a motion accepting a report by the Department of right of way payments in the State Secondary "C" Construction Program for Aiken, Beaufort, Charleston, Cherokee, Edgefield, Florence and York Counties, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 17: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of a 1989 Harley-Davidson motorcycle located at the Department's Maintenance Office on Park Avenue Extension, Aiken, South Carolina, bids for which were received on December 15, 1992, as shown in the Appendix.

SECTION 18: The Commission unanimously passed a motion approving the sale of surplus used motor vehicles and equipment located at the Department's Equipment Depot, Shop Road, Columbia, South Carolina, bids for which were received on December 16, 1992, as shown in the Appendix.

This study and subsequent drainage improvements would assist the Department in securing the permits necessary to widen S. C. 544 between the Intracoastal Waterway and U. S. 17 Business.

The estimated cost of the study is \$25,000.00. The Department, utilizing maintenance funds, would provide one-third (\$8,334.00) of the total estimated cost.

Consultant Services - Carolina Bays Parkway
File No. 26.831, Project Nos. DPI-0084(1),
DPI-0138(1) Horry and Georgetown Counties

The Department requests Commission approval to enter into Supplemental Agreement No. 3 with the Horry County Higher Education Commission (HEC) in order to obtain additional engineering services on the proposed Carolina Bays Parkway in Horry and Georgetown Counties. The HEC proposes to supplement their agreement with The LPA Group to secure aerial photography for use in location and conceptual design of alternative alignments and environmental analysis.

These services are estimated to cost \$205,000.00 and will be funded with 80% Federal (Innovative Projects) and 20% State funds.

Recommendations - 1/21/93

Contract for Engineering Services

Pursuant to the Commission's previous action of December 19, 1991 authorizing the Department to seek consultant services to provide preliminary engineering services to prepare plans and specifications for the SC 35 overpass over CSXRR/Godley Road/Monkey Spring Branch in Lexington County, the Department has entered into a contract with Moreland Altobelli Associates, Inc., in the amount of \$896,448.78. Funding for this project will be from the Surface Transportation Program with 80% Federal Funds and 20% State Funds.

Supplemental Agreements with
B. P. Barber and Associates

It is recommended that Supplemental Agreement Numbers 2 and 3 to the basic agreement between the Department and B. P. Barber and Associates, Inc. to provide consultant services for the upgrade of wastewater treatment at the I-26 rest area in Newberry County and the I-95 rest area in Colleton County be approved. Supplemental Agreement #2 is for office management and construction observation during construction of a sewer force main and pump stations from the Newberry rest area to the City of Newberry wastewater system. Supplemental Agreement #3 is for the same service connecting the I-95 rest area in Colleton County to the City of Walterboro wastewater system. The estimated cost for the two agreements is \$50,600.00.
