Description/Significant Features:

Main section has a rectangular plan and steeply pitched hipped roof. Central door has half-light transoms with two lower wooden panels on either side; it is flanked by paired two-over-two, double-hung, wooden sash windows on either side. Full-width, hipped roof porch, wraps around to the north elevation and is supported by square posts. The two-bay south elevation has paired two-over-two, double-hung, wooden sash windows, while the northern elevation has two additional entry doors and single two-over-two, double-hung, wooden sash windows. Single story, hipped roof addition has been appended to the rear of the structure.
