Description/Significant Features:

The historic core of the masonry Colonial Revival house stands two stories tall and three bays wide. A centrally placed door, which appears original, is framed by a large pedimented portico supported by Doric columns. Replacement multi-light windows are found on both the first and second floors of the building, and large exterior brick chimneys rise from both the eastern and western gable ends. A multi-bay frame addition, fronted by a porch, extends to the building's east, and a slightly smaller frame addition extends to the building's west.
