

December 15, 1943.

The Budget Commission met in the Governor's Office at 3:00 o'clock. All members of the Commission were present.

The following transfers were granted by the Commission:

State Department of Public Welfare

From Cash Assistance (b) Blind \$2,500.00 - To Miscellaneous
(c) Commodity Distribution

State Council of Defense

From Contingent Fund for Emergencies \$500.00 - To Special
payments - Clerical Help.

The following allotment was granted from the 1943-44 Civil
Contingent Fund:

Judicial Department \$600.00 to supplement salary of Supreme
Court Reporter.

The following allotment was granted from the Civil Contingent
Fund for National Defense:

State Colored College \$500.00 to defray expense of the meeting
of negro ministers in the interest of agriculture in the State.

The Commission instructed its Secretary to direct the Joint
Committee on Printing to order from Jacobs Press 100 additional copies
of the 1942 Code of Laws, in order that copies of the Code might be
furnished to members of the General Assembly who had not received them;
and that the Joint Committee pay for same from its current appropriation
for Printing. The Commission agreed to support a deficiency appropriation
to the Joint Committee on Printing if this expenditure caused a deficit
in its funds for Public Printing.

The Commission then adjourned.
