BACKGROUND:

Giving Days

Who: Hosted by Central Carolina Community Foundation (Midlands Gives), Waccamaw Foundation, Coastal Carolina Foundation (Lowcountry Unite), and Eastern Carolinas Foundation (Big Give)

What: Giving days are 24-hour online giving events that bring the various regions together as one community, raising money and awareness for local nonprofits in their corresponding counties. The One SC Fund is enrolled as a participating nonprofit in the giving days above.

Total Donations Since the Governor Announced the One SC Fund - \$1,332,035

Total Grants Awarded – 1st Round - \$500,000

2nd Round - \$760,000

3rd Round –\$420,000

Governor Haley and regional mayors including Steve Benjamin and Elise Partin to be on site at Midlands Gives 24-hour online giving day headquarters on Tuesday, May 3 at Spirit Communications Park

What: Midlands Gives is the annual, 24-hour local online giving challenge presented by Central Carolina Community Foundation, encouraging philanthropy in the Midlands and benefitting 383 local nonprofit organizations throughout the 11 Midlands counties served by the Foundation: Calhoun, Clarendon, Fairfield, Kershaw, Lee, Lexington, Newberry, Orangeburg, Richland, Saluda and Sumter Counties.

In 2015, Midlands Gives raised an astonishing \$1,543,032.65 for 251 charities, up from \$704,932.23 raised for 150 nonprofits in 2014, the event's inaugural year. Midlands Gives is one of almost 100 giving days that will be taking place in cities across America as part of Give Local America. Give online on May 3 at www.MidlandsGives.org.

Midlands Gives Headquarters will host a day full of free, family-friendly interactive events, including the following:

- Nonprofit Marketplace featuring tables manned by 70 local nonprofits from 8:00 a.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- Regional Mayors' Pitching Contest, sponsored by Nephron, from 11:45 a.m. to 12:30 p.m., featuring 12 Midlands mayors pitching for their favorite causes
- Live broadcasts by local TV and radio stations throughout the day, during which nonprofits supporters are encouraged to bring signs and cheer for their causes (5:00 a.m. to 10:00 a.m.; 12:00 p.m. to 12:30 p.m.; 4:00 p.m. to 7:30 p.m.; 11:00 p.m. to 11:30 p.m.)
- Food and drink concessions during lunch, 11:00 a.m. to 1:30 p.m.
- Governor Nikki Haley on site for official visit between 1:00 p.m. and 2:00 p.m.
- Happy Hour with food, beer and wine concessions, 4:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- A live concert during happy hour by the Heart n' Soul band, 5:00 p.m. to 8:00 p.m.
- A meet-and-greet with the Columbia Fireflies mascot, Mason, 5:30 p.m. to 6:30 p.m.
- Staff on site from midnight to midnight managing the online giving challenge
- Nonprofits on site from 5:00 a.m. to midnight for media interviews

When: 12:01 a.m. – 11:59 p.m., Tuesday, May 3, 2016

Where: Midlands Gives headquarters will be on the concourse level of Spirit Communications Park, in the new BullStreet development in downtown Columbia, S.C.

Press check-in is at the Midlands Gives welcome desk at the ballpark entrance plaza, where media will receive credentials and be directed to find the Flock and Rally PR team on the concourse or in the VIP room (McWaters Conference Room, next to Concessions). Limited reserved parking for media will be provided along the north side of the ballpark on Freed St., where Suite Parking is normally hosted during games.

Who: Central Carolina Community Foundation and 383 local 501c 3 nonprofits, to whom online donations can be made on May 3 via www.MidlandsGives.org.

Governor Nikki Haley is expected to be on site for an official visit between 1:00 and 2:00 p.m.

The Mayors' Pitching Contest (11:45 a.m to 12:30 p.m.), sponsored by Nephron, will feature Columbia Mayor Benjamin; Cayce Mayor Elise Partin; Lexington Mayor Steve MacDougall; West Columbia Mayor Bobby Horton; Pine Ridge Mayor David Busby; Springdale Mayor Michael Bishop; Chapin Mayor Skip Wilson; Camden Mayor Tony Scully; Blythewood Mayor J. Michael Ross; and Ridgeway Mayor Charlene N. Herring, as well as Nephron's Lou Kennedy and Bill Kennedy.

Why: Midlands Gives has grown astronomically since launching in 2014; the excitement of tracking the leaderboard of total donations reaches a fever pitch as the day goes on. More than \$95,000 in prizes for the charities, donated by local Corporate Philanthropy Champions like Aflac and SCE&G, increase the anticipation even further. Now that headquarters is at the new ballpark and open to the public, an extremely vibrant and energetic atmosphere is expected for Midlands Gives, a fun and easy way for community members to give online and rally around their favorite local charities.
