**Letter of Notice to Operate as Free Spirit Living Man**

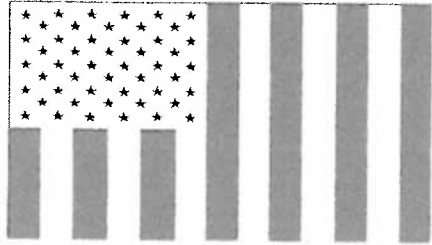

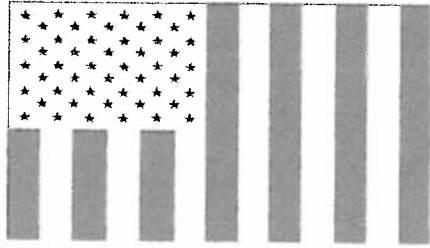

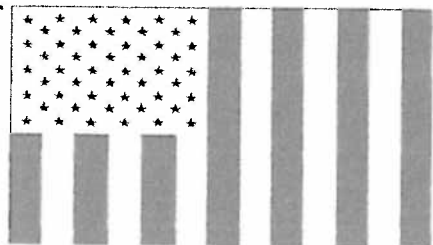
(7)Par. II. Legislative acts in violation of this Constitution, or the Constitution of the United States, are void, and the Judiciary shall so declare them.

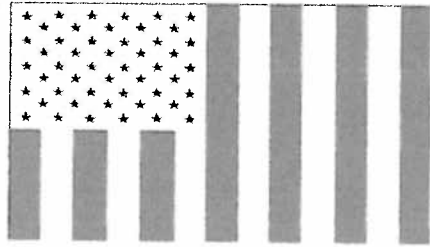
