Recent activities

New MB Van plant in Charleston, South Carolina

- Investment of about 500 Million US-Dollar in a new van plant, construction starts in 2016.
- Backup and expansion of employment in the factory.
- Increasing the market position and share of the Mercedes-Benz Sprinter.
- Extension and stabilization of the local supplier portfolio in the metropolitan area of Charleston.

Future activities

Currently in focus

- Participation in a major US Postal Services tender with the current Sprinter (approx. 10.000 Units, delivery in 2016), METRIS (approx. 23.000 Units, delivery not announced yet) and the Sprinter successor (approx. 140.000 Units, delivery in 2018).

Recent MB Vans product portfolio

- Volume of 23.000 Units; delivery period has not been published so far.
- Mercedes-Benz Vans provides US Postal two right-hand driven METRIS as demo vehicles for testing in June 2015.

- Volume of 10.000 Units; delivery period is from 2016 onwards.
- Mercedes-Benz Vans provides US Postal two right-hand driven Sprinters equipped with shelving as demo vehicles for testing in June 2015.
