The symposium will communicate the latest technology and information regarding poultry waste management. The symposium is targeted to meet current and future needs of the poultry industry when responsibly dealing with environmental issues. The program begins with a general session covering broad topics related to poultry by-products and social issues, followed by concurrent sessions addressing specific issues such as air and water quality, utilization and marketing alternatives and regulation. The target audience is mid-level managers, University and allied industry personnel, regulators, growers and farmers. 1st Fall Ag Study Tour includes Sunbelt Expo

The 2000 Fall Agricultural Study Tour will be to South Georgia and Mid-Florida on Oct. 15-21. This is the first fall tour, and also the first "all bus" tour.

Tourists are in for a special treat, as the tour group will visit the annual Sunbelt Agricultural Exposition in Moultrie, Ga., for a half-day. This expo holds 117,000 square feet of indoor exhibit space in four agribusiness buildings and one consumer living building. The 600-acre working farm at the Expo offers demonstrations on crop harvesting and tillage of corn, cotton, hay, peanuts, sorghum and soybeans. You can inspect a variety of equipment and the latest technology. From the expo, the tour group will visit individual farming and agribusiness firms from South Georgia to Central Florida. Participants will learn agricultural techniques with a hands-on approach from on-site visits. Department of Agriculture staff and personnel from the universities of Georgia and Florida will accompany the group each day to answer questions and give information.

A little of everything is included in the trip—agribusiness, farming and manufacturing. A few highlights of the tour include a visit to an ag/cropduster airplane manufacturer, a golf course management program, greenhouses that grow hydrophobic tomatoes, a forestry fire ecology project, a specialty sawmill for the furniture industry, an angus beef cattle farm, a citrus operation and packer, potato and onion operation, a fruit and vegetable radiology treatment facility and much more.

The Ag Study Tours are meant to give South Carolinians the opportunity to learn new and innovative production and marketing techniques suitable for their own operations.

This agricultural tour is informative, fun and affordable. There is only space for 45 people, so reserve your space now. If you sign up by July 24, the cost is \$895 per person or \$1700 per couple. The regular price is \$960 per person and \$1840 per couple. A \$500 deposit is required at sign-up. Refunds will be available in full until August 1. Longleaf Pine drawing to be held in July

This 1999-2000 planting season experienced an unprecedented demand for longleaf seedlings in the South. The South Carolina Forestry Commission received orders for ten million longleaf pine seedlings in 1999 but our nurseries were only able to produce six million longleaf.

The Forestry Commission's Taylor Nursery in Trenton, SC, is the south's second largest producer of bareroot longleaf pine seedlings. But the unprecedented surge in demand has led to an anticipated shortage here and at nurseries throughout the south. The increase in demand for longleaf pine is related to new cost-share incentives, especially from the Conservation Reserve Program (CRP). Rural landowners who opt to plant formerly agricultural land in grasses or trees have traditionally been eligible for CRP cost-share payments. Recently the program made re-establishment of longleaf pine in its natural habitat a priority area for funding.

Demand for longleaf pine seedlings will continue to be high this coming year. In order to fairly distribute as many seedlings as possible to the most people the Forestry Commission will hold a random drawing as described below.

1. A random drawing will be held at 1:00 p.m. on July 11 for all longleaf pine orders received from July 1 to 1:00 p.m., July 11. No preference will be given for type of order or method of order delivery. Once trees are sold out, a sequential waiting list will be created by lot from the orders remaining in the drawing. Orders placed after the drawing will be added to the waiting list as received.

2. Orders for longleaf pine seedlings, whether bareroot, containerized or a combination, will be limited to 25,000 trees per customer.

TIPS:

Mail your order form on July 1. Orders received in June may be returned since the new fiscal year begins July 1.

Apply for longleaf pine on a separate application if you are ordering a variety of other seedlings. It won't affect your chances of getting longleaf but it will simplify processing your order for the other species.

This should give as many people as possible the same opportunity to receive longleaf seedlings. We will continue to maximize our longleaf production to serve as many people as possible in the future.

Commissioner's Column

Five a day to a healthy lifestyle

Isn't it good to know that eating South Carolina grown products can also help reduce your risk for cancer? It's a fact that most of our agricultural products can help your body fight cancer if they are included in your daily diet.

We've always known that fruits and vegetables help us lead healthier—and thinner—lives. We also know that South Carolina grows wonderful peaches (we're Number 2 in peach production), apples, melons, cucumbers, tomatoes, beans, greens, and much more. Unfortunately, we're not taking full advantage of the wide variety of fruits and vegetables we have at our disposal. In fact, only 21.8 percent of South Carolinians are eating the recommended five-to-nine servings of fruits and vegetables a day, according to the Centers for Disease Control. That's below the 23.8 percent national average, and our national ranking is 35th.

Knowing all the health benefits of fruits and vegetables, along with the fact that they are so easily accessible to us, should lead us to increase our consumption of these ultra-healthy foods. The Produce for Better Health Foundation estimates that Americans are increasing the amounts of fruits and vegetables they consume, but only by about half a serving over the past few years.

June is Fresh Fruit and Vegetable month—as well as Father's Day—so it's time to follow our fathers' advice and put fruits and vegetables on our plates. Our health depends on it. Fruits and vegetables are important not only in reducing the risk of developing certain types of cancer, but also in reducing the risk of heart disease, diabetes, stroke, obesity and birth defects.

Take a moment to consider your daily meals and snacks. Do YOU have a balanced, healthy diet? Let's start with breakfast. Did you know that more than twice as many people choose coffee for breakfast instead of a healthier alternative? We could greatly increase our daily dose of vitamins and minerals if we started the day off right—with fruit.

Fruits and veggies also make great snacks, and Americans are known for snacking. Unfortunately, you can't get an apple out of a vending machine at work, so plan ahead and take healthy snacks from home. Lunchtime meals generally don't contain any more fruits and vegetables than breakfast, but a simple salad can fix that problem. Whether you eat a salad for your lunch meal or as an addition to your meal, you're that much closer to five a day!

Dinnertime is our best time for eating right, but we still aren't getting enough fruits and vegetables. The federal government recommends five-to-nine servings of fruits and vegetables each day, which means dinner should contain at least three. However, Americans are still not eating the minimum number of servings. American adults average 4.4 servings while children average only 3.4 servings each day. It's time to add some nutrition—and taste—to our meals, and make sure our children appreciate the importance of eating fruits and vegetables.

Fathers and health experts have taught us a lot about how to live longer, healthier lives, so it's up to us to follow their advice—eat well! Happy Fathers Day!

— On average we eat less than one vegetable snack per month and approximately five fruits or fruit juices per month.

—When you take a look at our top eight snacks, vegetables come in last at 3 percent and fruits are number four at 15 percent.

—More than \$250 billion are spent each year on health-care costs due to diet-related diseases—diets that are too high in fat and too low in fruits and vegetables.

Miz May's tips for freezing corn

Fresh sweet corn is one of South Carolina's summer highlights, but most folks like to enjoy it year-round. So Mrs. Les Tindal, "Miz May," once again shares her favorite recipe for freezing corn off the cob: Take 20 cups of corn, 5 cups ice water, 1/4 cup salt, 1/4 - 3/4 cups sugar (to individual taste), mix well, put into a container and freeze. Blanching is *not* required. Thaw and pour off excess water before cooking.
