**Subject:** Lawmakers attempting to ram through tax hike – again

I wanted to let you know about some shenanigans going on at the State House today. The subject? **A massive fee and tax hike on just about every taxpayer in the state.**

The bill raises hundreds of millions in new taxes in order to pour more money into our unaccountable road funding system – giving us the same system we have already, but forcing us to pay more for it. Over the past few weeks, remember, a few senators have been holding illegal **secret meetings** about the tax hike legislation. So we knew to expect something odd. And when some members seemed confused about what was happening, while others remained uncharacteristically quiet, we were pretty sure something sketchy was happening.

Without getting into the procedural weeds, it wasn't clear how the Senate Finance committee *even had the authority to consider the bill at all*. It was still on the Senate calendar, and hadn't been recommitted to

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Senate Finance. Senator Hugh Leatherman, who chairs the committee, wasn't inclined to explain what was going on.

So what was going on? We don't know – yet.

But here's what we *do* know. Lawmakers who want a tax increase – House and Senate members who want to leave our opaque and unaccountable system as it is – are ready to ram this tax hike through any way they can. They're going to try, and in the end they may get away with it.

Emphasis on the word *may*.

Here's what we *also* know, however. **They aren't going to do it in secret.** We aren't going to let them. We're going to report and publicize every move they make, and we're going to do it relentlessly, on weekdays and on weekends, for as long as it takes.
