Have you heard them? The frogs have been calling after dark for months now in our state parks, and maybe in your neighborhoods. At Paris Mountain State Park, we've been hearing the low 'jugarum' of the bullfrog, the high-low quacking of the green tree frog, the quick buzz of the gray tree frog, and the long WAAAH of the Fowlers toad. If you are near a lake, or even if you aren't, you may be hearing these choruses, provided by the male frogs as they call out to female frogs. These sounds may not be everyone's idea of the call of the wild, but they are a reassuring affirmation that life continues as long as habitat is protected. See a green tree frog pictured here!
