WHEREAS, the 2013 observance of Public Works Week raises awareness of the contributions of public works officials to the planning, design, construction, performance, and maintenance of our public infrastructure and public works services.

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Nikki R. Haley, Governor of the Great State of South Carolina, do hereby proclaim May 19-25, 2013, as
