Dear Christian and John,

As I believe you know, ICS had invited Jeff Liebman some weeks ago to participate in the April 23<sup>rd</sup> meeting of the Social Impact Finance Working Group. He accepted this invitation. While he is in the state, we would like to use his presence as wisely as possible and that would include an opportunity to meet with government stakeholders.

I understand that DHHS has its full Senate finance budget presentation on the afternoon of April 23<sup>rd</sup> that precludes a meeting with him that day, *but I was wondering if that would also preclude a meeting on the afternoon of April 22<sup>nd</sup> with Jeff and Megan Golden should Jeff be available to come into Columbia midday on Monday, April 22<sup>nd</sup>.* If we were able to meet then that would allow all of the stakeholders to sit down together to hear both Megan's presentation on the numbers related to an NFP SIB (this will be prior to the finalization of her analysis, but we will have good preliminary data on how the numbers for that SIB would work) and to hear from Jeff about next steps with the Harvard SIB TA.

If it simply does not work for y'all to meet on that Monday afternoon, then we will schedule another Social Impact Finance working group meeting for Jeff to attend in May and invite Megan to return to present to y'all the findings on the NFP SIB feasibility study.
