Upon the request of Dr. C. Fred Williams, Superintendent, the State Hospital was granted an additional appropriation of \$25,000.00 under Section 117 of the 1942-43 General Appropriation Act.

The approval of the Commission was given to an expenditure of \$700.00 from the "Fund for Contingencies" of the South Carolina Council for National Defense, to the Richland County Defense Council, to defray the expense of distributing Ration Books Nos. 3 and 4 throughout the State.
