COLUMBIA, SC – Governor Nikki Haley announced Christy Hall as the next Secretary of the South Carolina Department of Transportation (SCDOT).

"Many of you know Christy Hall – she has been at the Department of Transportation for over 20 years, and has been a staple there," said Gov. Nikki Haley.
