Richele:

The definition of public record in S.C. Code Ann. § 30-4-20(c) states: “Information relating to **security plans and devices proposed, adopted, installed, or utilized by a public body**, other than amounts expended for adoption, implementation, or installation of these plans and devices, **is required to be closed to the public and is not considered to be made open to the public under the provisions of this act.**” (emphasis added). As such, in my opinion, information related to the Governor’s security team and security plans are not public records.
