TAX TIP TUESDAY

Tax scams are all around. **Don't fall for it!**

If you receive a call from someone impersonating an IRS employee, please note that the IRS will **never**:

- Call to demand immediate payment over the phone, nor will the agency call about taxes owed without first having mailed you a bill.
- Threaten to immediately bring in local police or other law-enforcement groups to have you arrested for not paying.
- Demand that you pay taxes without giving you the opportunity to question or appeal the amount they say you owe.
- Require you to use a specific payment method for your taxes, such as a prepaid debit card.
- Ask for credit or debit card numbers over the phone.

MODERNIZING WITHHOLDING: *change is a good thing*

In January 2017, South Carolina is updating Withholding Tax tables for the first time in 25 years. This is a big change to South Carolina's Withholding process, and we want you to be ready!

Are you an employer, accountant, or payroll provider? You will need to update the Withholding tables that your payroll systems use for January 2017.

Are you an individual taxpayer? No action is necessary to prepare for this change. Beginning in 2017, you may notice a very small increase in your paychecks throughout the year which will result in a slightly smaller South Carolina income tax refund in 2018.
