


The Budget Commission met at the Wade Hampton Hotel, Tuesday, November 4, 1941, at 12:30 P. M. Senator Jefferies and Mr. Winchester Smith were present as members of the Budget Commission. Ex-Governor Maybank, though not officially a member of the Budget Commission, also attended this meeting.

The Commission discussed at length the recommendations that would be made to the General Assembly as to appropriations for the year 1942-43. The Secretary was directed to prepare tentative recommendations consistent with certain policies agreed upon by the Commission, and upon completion of same to ask the Commission to meet again for further consideration of the Budget report.

The Commission then adjourned.
